Dear Mike Newdow,

Thank you very much for your commitment to participate as our phone bank volunteers during KVIE's 2008 Membership Drive. Your scheduled shift is: 6/2/2008 from 6:15 pm - 11:00 pm. Please bring 16 to 20 people aged sixteen and older. Note that youth groups under age twenty are required to bring an adult supervisor.

We want you to enjoy your experience at KVIE, so here are a few things to pass along to your members:

~Logistics~

KVIE is participating in a research project with only fifteen other PBS stations in the country. So, phone bank volunteers will be entering membership data in a computer. It is not necessary to be a computer wiz, but basic computer skills are necessary: complete training is provided and everything is scripted. It's fun and easy!

Phone bank volunteers will enter the building through the staff/volunteer lounge located at the patio area, which is to the far left of the main entrance, at the southeast corner of the building. You will see the directional signs. A map to the station is also enclosed. There is plenty of parking at the KVIE studios, however please note that construction is taking place around the KVIE studios and phone bank volunteers should anticipate modified driving routes into the KVIE parking lots as noted on our map.

Your scheduled shift includes time for orientation. There is no need to arrive earlier. If you decide to have a potluck, or have food delivered, you will have time in between pledge breaks to eat and socialize. Your group needs to arrive for the orientation at 6:15 pm. However, if you want to eat *before* the training and pledge breaks please come before 6:15 pm. Please let me know if you will be arriving early, so I will be here to let you into the building.

Coffee and light snacks are provided. Other snacks and soft drink vending machines are available. Tables, chairs, refrigerators and microwave ovens are available and set up in the volunteer lounge. Enclosed is a list of restaurants in the KVIE area.





FCC regulations prohibit alcoholic beverages on the premises.

You are welcomed to bring cameras and camcorders to photograph or record your group (NO FLASH IS NEEDED). Unfortunately, KVIE is unable to provide you with a tape of your participation. Tell a friend, family member or neighbor to tape it for you – it's a great souvenir!

You may bring two 11" x 8 ½" signs promoting your organization. The horizontal signs will be displayed at the end of the phone bank row. Unfortunately, our studio is not designed to accommodate banners.

We have brought back the popular "Call-Out" Program. It is a fun way for you to invite your friends and family to help support KVIE and become a new or renewing member. There is a prize for the person who brings in the highest amount of donations during their shift by making these calls to friends and family. And all participants during that pledge drive will be entered into a drawing for even bigger prizes! Bring your phone lists and have some fun!

Please be aware that not all of our pledge shifts are "live." When a pledge break is "live" there are hosts, called Talent, and a live crew in the studio with you. When a pledge break is "virtual" or an "air-check" there is not a host or studio crew – however, your group will appear live on TV whenever the control room cuts away to you when you look busy on the phones.

Often times we do not know if the shifts are going to be live or virtual until the week of the pledge drive. If you would like to know what show will be on and if it is a live or virtual shift please call me with those queries. Please note that programs are subject to change without notice.

~ TV Attire~

If your group has an identifying shirt or cap we encourage you to wear them. A coordinated group looks great on camera! If not, business attire is requested. Due to the fluctuating temperature in the studio, you should tell your volunteers to bring a sweater or jacket – it gets chilly! Colorful clothing is always better than plain black or white – colors look great on camera! Whatever you wear make sure to keep it comfortable!

~Sign Up Deadline~

Feel free to post the enclosed flyer in any communal location of your organization to help recruit your 16 volunteers. It's a good idea to put the roster close to the flyer so people can easily sign up. If you would like an electronic version of any of these forms I can email them to you for easy printing and/or forwarding on to your members.

Please stress to your volunteers the importance of their participation. We are counting on them to fulfill their commitment to their pledge shift! Thank you for understanding that cancellations are not accepted after a phone bank group has committed to a shift.

So bring your spouse, neighbors, friends from church – whoever it takes to meet the minimum number of people for your phone bank. If you are unable to meet the required minimum of 16 people, please let me know as soon as possible. We may be able to fill in a few of the empty spaces with "Friends of KVIE" emergency volunteers.

We are so grateful for your support. Volunteer phone banks are pivotal to the success of our onair fund drives. Whether the breaks are live or pre-taped events, your group will appear on camera! Your group's participation helps us keep our commitment to produce and broadcast intelligent programs that enrich the lives of thousands of viewers throughout the Central Valley.



Northbound Interstate 5
